

HOME PLATE 2026 – SCHEDULE FOR JUNE 6

8:45 AM - 9:50 AM:

*Arrival at Comerica Park. Gate A will be used for admission. It will open at 8:45 AM and is located along the Woodward Ave side of the stadium (first base side).

*Bus Parking – Limited bus parking is free near Comerica Park on a first-come basis along the I-75 Service Drive (south side). Please arrive early

*Vans and cars will find parking lots operated by Olympia Development around Comerica Park. It is possible that you may find other parking lots open in the Grand Circus Park area or elsewhere. Prepaid parking and parking maps can be found at www.ParkDistrictDetroit.com.

*Everyone entering Comerica Park for the HOME PLATE Program must have a game ticket for June 6.

***EVERYONE MUST BE SEATED BY 9:50 AM.** Seating for the HOME PLATE program will be available on a first-come basis in the lower deck along the first base foul line. Since most of the seats at Comerica Park are out in the open, you may want to bring a hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc. to protect yourself from the sun. Please be sure to allow enough time to enter Comerica Park and locate seats. Anyone arriving late will be seated toward the rear of a section. **PLEASE NOTE: GATES TO OUR EVENT WILL CLOSE AT 10:30 AM AND WILL NOT REOPEN UNTIL 11:30 AM WHEN THE GENERAL PUBLIC ENTERS THE BALLPARK.**

10:00 - 11:20 AM:

*Our program will begin at 10:00 AM.

*Several of our program participants will be speaking about their lives in professional sports and their faith in Jesus Christ.

*Reserved seating for hearing impaired is located along the front railing.

11:30 AM – 1:10 PM:

*Concession areas will be open and there are many baseball displays and statues to view around the lower concourse.

*With a late mealtime, you may want to eat before coming to this event.

1:10 PM:

*The game begins at this time. If the game does not go into extra innings and there are no rain delays, it should conclude by 4:10 PM.

**In the event of inclement weather, we will still have the program. Umbrellas (small popup with no metal tip) are permitted in Comerica Park and would be needed during the program in the event of rain. If the game is an official rainout, your ticket is still valid for the rescheduled game or another game date in accordance with the Detroit Tiger policies listed on the Tigers' web site.

**In the event that the Friday night game (June 5) is postponed and rescheduled as part of a doubleheader on Saturday, June 6, the HOME PLATE 2026 program will take place at the same time before the first game. Game tickets will be honored for the first game.

**In the event that the HOME PLATE program has to be completely cancelled (this has never happened), it will not be rescheduled and there is no refund for the program portion of the ticket. The game ticket may still be used in accordance with the Detroit Tiger policies listed on the back of your game ticket and on the Tigers' web site.

All of our program participants are looking forward to being with us at HOME PLATE 2026. However, due to the nature of their professions, circumstances beyond their control (injuries, trades, schedule changes, etc.) could prevent one or all of them from being at the program. **IT IS UNLIKELY THIS WOULD HAPPEN. If it should happen, we will have an alternative program and speakers planned.
